



What do I need to bring to Boots & Bells!!!

- a table-top/stand up/folding 3-ring music binder – **MAKE SURE NAME IS ON BINDER**
- sharpened pencils
- If you are in the Festival Conference Choir, remember to bring your music!!
- mallets for your ringing assignment – **LABEL WITH YOUR NAME/CHURCH/GROUP NAME**
- gloves – can be black, white, or whatever! You will use 'loaner' equipment – ***gloves are required.***
- small clips or tabs for page turns (optional)
- pencil pouch or small bag to hold 'your' gloves, pencils, clips, etc. – **LABEL WITH YOUR NAME IF NOT ATTACHED TO MUSIC BINDER**
- if available, dowels that are used for the "Singing Bell" technique
- completed **Emergency Release Form** for all youth 18 and younger
- completed **Chaperone Form** for all chaperones
- **OPTIONAL:** a baton (if available) if you plan to take the Conducting Class; any music you need conducting help
- **OPTIONAL:** any "problem" bells you might have (please, no complete sets!) that you want to take to the Maintenance Classes.
- comfortable clothing and shoes – remember hotels can be 'chilly' so you may want a sweater
 - **SOLID COLOR SHIRT** for closing concert – please no tie-dye!
 - **'NICE CASUAL'** attire for Saturday evening Ring of Fame Banquet
- cash/credit card!!! There will be fun stuff and necessities available for purchase. Be prepared to **SHOP the VENDORS!**
- small energy snacks and drinks – each room has a refrigerator and a microwave
- energy for fellowship and friendship and an attitude of openness for learning and returning home a better and improved handbell musician
